Dear Supervisor Cunningham:

On behalf of the Housing Trust Fund Corporation's Office of Community Renewal (OCR), thank you for applying for New York State Community Development Block Grant (NYS CDBG) Public Facility funding through the 2017 NYS Consolidated Funding Application (CFA). As part of the application review process, applications undergo a threshold and completeness review to determine the eligibility of the applicant and the activities proposed.

The OCR regrets to inform the Town of Bergen that the application was determined to be ineligible for consideration because the activities proposed were not in compliance with the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development's (HUD) Community Development Block Grant Program requirements. Specifically:

The Town of Bergen requested NYS CDBG funding assistance for accessibility improvements to the Town Hall.

The Town of Bergen has failed to hold the required public hearing prior to submission of the application as per 24CFR570.486(a)(5) and in compliance with NYS Open Meeting Law Section 104. While the Town provided evidence that a hearing was held prior to submission, the Town failed to meet the required notice period of seven (7) days. The notice for the hearing was published on June 24, 2017 with the actual hearing held June 27, 2017. This determination of your OCR application does not pertain to potential funding awards or applications submitted to other agencies or programs through the CFA.

Thank you again for your application. We look forward to assisting the Town of Bergen in developing a stronger project and application for upcoming funding opportunities. NYS CDBG program staff is available to provide technical assistance in building grant administration and program capacity throughout the year.
