NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

In the Matter of the Establishment of Water
Improvement Benefit Area No. 1 in the Town of Bergen,
in the County of Genesee, in the State of New York

WHEREAS, the Town Board of the Town of Bergen previously adopted a Resolution directing Chatfield Engineers, P.C. n/k/a MRB Group (“MRB”) to supervise in the preparation of a map, plan and report for providing the facilities, improvements or services in a portion of the Town of Bergen, wherein a water district is proposed to be established, and

WHEREAS, on or about December 4, 2018, MRB duly filed said map, plan and report in the Office of the Town Clerk of the Town of Bergen, and

WHEREAS, the map, plan and report was revised and updated on February 5, 2019, and May 17, 2019, and filed in the Office of the Town Clerk of the Town of Bergen, and

WHEREAS, on or about August 13, 2019, the Town Board was presented with a petition for the establishment of said water district, and

WHEREAS, public water will be provided to approximately 513 parcels of land within the Town of Bergen, along portions of the following roads; Clinton Street Road (NYS Route 33), Jerico Road, Dublin Road, West Bergen Road, Lyman Road, Gilbert Road, Old State Road, Connelly Road, West Sweden Road, Creamery Road, Sackett Road, Cook Road, Warboys Road, Sautell Road, North Bergen Road, Reed Road, Evans Road, Swamp Road, Pocock Road, Maple Avenue, North Lake Road (NYS Route 19), Peachey Road, Buffalo Road, and

WHEREAS, the boundaries of the proposed water district (“Water Improvement Benefit Area No. 1”) are more particularly described upon Exhibit “A” attached hereto, and

WHEREAS, the improvements proposed consist of the installation of approximately 163,720 linear feet of 8”, 10” and 12” diameter water main, valves, hydrants, services and appurtenances along various roads in the Town of Bergen as set forth and in the map, plan and report on file in the Office of the Town Clerk of the Town, and

WHEREAS, the maximum amount to be expended for the construction of said water service by Water Improvement Benefit Area No. 1 shall be hereafter contracted by the Bergen Town Board acting for and on behalf of said water district, and the maximum amount proposed to be expended for such improvements is \$8,958,000.00, to be offset by a United States Department of Agriculture Grant of \$3,058,000, said total annual cost to be borne by the properties within the district on a benefit basis, and

WHEREAS, the total annual cost for a typical user of the proposed Water Improvement Benefit Area No. 1 is estimated to be approximately \$924.94 including debt service, water cost and repair reserve, and as such, the formation of the Water District will be subject to the approval of the Office of State Comptroller, and

WHEREAS, the proposed method to be employed for financing such improvement is as follows:

The cost of the construction would be paid through a benefit based tax against the properties within the proposed Water Improvement Benefit Area No. 1. It is anticipated that the project cost will be financed by the issuance of one or more bonds of the Town, to be paid over 38 years at an interest rate not to exceed 2.5 % per annum,

and,

WHEREAS, the total first year cost for the typical user is estimated at approximately \$2,564.94, broken down as follows: Installation of Water Service \$1,200.00; Internal Plumbing Changes \$200.00; Repayment of Bonds \$557.04; Meter and Account Fee \$240.00; Repair Reserve \$20.00; Purchase of Water \$347.90, and

WHEREAS, the map, plan and report describing such improvements are on file in the Office of the Town Clerk of the Town of Bergen for public inspection;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED, that the Town Board of the Town of Bergen shall meet at the Byron Bergen High School Auditorium,, 6917 West Bergen Road, Bergen, New York, 14416 on the 5th day of September, 2019 at 7:00 o'clock p.m., for the purpose of conducting a public hearing on the proposal to establish said water district with improvements specified above, at which time all persons interested in the subject thereof may be heard concerning the same, and it is further

ORDERED, that the Town Clerk of the Town of Bergen is hereby authorized and directed to publish a copy of this Notice of Public Hearing in the Town's official newspaper, and post a copy of the same on the signboard of the Town of Bergen in the time and manner required by law.

RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING WATER IMPROVEMENT BENEFIT AREA NO. 1 PURSUANT TO ARTICLE 12 OF THE TOWN LAW

In the Matter of the Establishment of Water Improvement Benefit Area No. 1 in the Town of Bergen, in the County of Genesee, in the State of New York

WHEREAS, previous hereto, a map, plan, and report have been prepared by Chatfield Engineers n/k/a MRB Group (“MRB”) in such manner and in such detail as heretofore determined by the Town Board relating to the establishment of a proposed water district, to be known and designated as Water Improvement Benefit Area No. 1 in the Town of Bergen (the “Town”), and

WHEREAS, on or about August 13, 2019, the Town Board was presented with a petition(s) for the establishment of said water district, and

WHEREAS, the proposed action before the Town Board is limited to the creation of the water district (the “Project”), and

WHEREAS, the Town Board having previously declared itself Lead Agent pursuant to the State Environment Quality Review Act (“SEQR”) and having previously reviewed and accepted a long form environmental assessment of the Project prepared by LaBella Associates,

and declared that based upon a review of the assessment, the Project will not have a significant adverse impact on the environment and issued a Negative Declaration under SEQR for the Project, and

WHEREAS, after MRB duly filed said map, plan, and report in the office of the Town Clerk of the Town, reciting a description of the boundaries of the proposed district, the maximum amount proposed to be expended for the improvement, the cost to a typical user, the Town Board did conduct a public hearing on September 5, 2019 regarding the proposal to establish the water district to hear all persons interested in the subject thereof concerning the same, and

WHEREAS, copies of the Notice of Public Hearing were duly published and posted according to law, and the Town Board did, at the time and place specified in said Notice, duly meet and consider said proposal and hear all persons interested in the subject thereof, who appeared at such time and place, concerning the same, and

WHEREAS, the evidence offered at such time and place requires that the Town Board make the determinations hereafter made;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED, by the Town Board of the Town of Bergen, in the County of Genesee, that it be and hereby is determined as follows:

1. The Petition(s) were duly signed and acknowledged as required by law and are otherwise sufficient;
2. All of the property and property owners within the proposed water district are benefited thereby;
3. All of the property and property owners benefited are included within the proposed water district;

4. It is in the public interest to establish the proposed water district as hereinafter described, and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the Town Board does hereby approve the establishment of a water district as hereinafter described to be known as Water Improvement Benefit Area No. 1, in the Town of Bergen (the "District"), the boundaries of which are set forth more particularly in the attached Schedule A; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the following improvements in the District will be installed with the required funds being made available or provided for: the installation of approximately 163,720 linear feet of 8", 10" and 12" diameter water main, valves, hydrants, services and appurtenances along various roads in the Town of Bergen as set forth and in the map, plan and report on file in the Office of the Town Clerk of the Town; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the proposed improvements, including costs of the physical improvements, construction costs, legal fees, and other expenses in the amount of \$8,950,000.00 to be offset by a United States Department of Agriculture grant of \$3,058,000 will be borne by the properties within the District on a benefits basis; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the total annual cost for a typical user of the District is estimated at \$924.94 and as such formation of the District will be subject to the approval of the Office of the State Comptroller; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the proposed method to be employed for financing such improvement is projected as follows:

The cost of the water district construction would be paid through a benefit based assessment against the properties within the proposed water district. It is anticipated that the project cost will be financed by the issuance of one or more bonds of the Town, to be paid over 38 years at an estimated interest rate of 2.5%

per annum to be reduced by a grant from the United States Department of Agriculture & Rural Development; and be it

FURTHER RESOLVED, that the total first year cost for an average user of the proposed Water Improvement Benefit Area No. 1 is estimated at \$2,564.94 broken down as follows: Installation of Water Service \$1,200; Internal Plumbing Changes \$200.00; Repayment of Bonds \$557.04; Annual Meter Account Fee \$240.00; Repair Reserve \$20.00; and Purchase of Water \$347.90.






Overall Project Details

- *163,720 LF of water main to be installed.*
- *Provide water to approximately 388 buildings (homes and businesses).*
- *Water made available to vacant buildable parcels.*
- *Fire hydrants located 600' apart and at intersections.*
- *Water services provided to each existing home and business that signs up for a water service.*
- *Improvements generally installed within the Right-of-Way's.*

Overall Project Details (Cont.)

- MCWA operates and maintains the Bergen Water System under a "Retail Lease Agreement".
- Average Home utilizes 60,000 gal./year of water.
- Total Estimated Project Cost = \$8,958,000
- Less USDA RD Grant Amount = (\$3,058,000)
- **USDA RD Loan Amount** = **\$5,900,000**
- Project may be completed in multiple contracts due to project size.





USDA Rural Development Funding Project!

- *Receiving a \$3,058,000 Grant*
- *Receiving a \$5,900,000 Loan*
- *Loan is 2.5% interest rate for 38 years*

How are Equivalent Dwelling Units (EDU's) Applied?

- **Residential Properties:**
 - 1 family home = 1 EDU
 - 2 family home = 2 EDU; etc.
- **Commercial Properties:** 1 EDU minimum;
Additional EDU's based upon water usage.
- **Vacant Lots:** Charge 0.50 EDU per vacant buildable lot.
- **Landlocked Parcels:** 0 unit (unless owner also owns an adjacent parcel with road frontage - then 0.50 EDU).

Special Rules for Ag Parcels

- *Parcels in agricultural production in an Ag District are totally exempt from special assessments for water EXCEPT for a house and 1 acre, and any farm buildings that connect to the public water.*

Homeowners Responsibility

- *Install Water Service from ROW to house.*
- *Abandon wells or separate from well supply and Internal Plumbing Changes.*
- *MCWA Meter & Initial Account Fee (\$240 One time only).*
- *Homes > 500' from WM will require meter tile for meter.*
- *Purchase Water and comply with MCWA Requirements.*

Can I keep my Private Well?

MCWA offers the following Options:

- **Option 1 Well Abandonment:** No Cost to Homeowner.
(This is the preferred Option).
- **Option 2 Well Separation:** One-time Easement Fee of \$500 + \$80 Inspection Fee every 5 years.
- **Option 3 Backflow Prevention Device:** Must be designed by a NYS Licensed Professional Engineer and must be tested annually. This option is the most costly.

Note: The final decision regarding Option 2 & 3 is up to the MCWA based upon groundwater conditions in the area.



Role of MCWA

- *Provide technical assistance and review/approval of plans and specifications.*
- *Supply potable water meeting or exceeding State and Federal Standards.*
- *Operate and maintain water supply and distribution system.*
- *Coordinate new service installations and well abandonment's.*
- *Set up new customer accounts and perform all billing.*



Advantages of a Public Water System

- *Consistent Quality and Quantity.*
- *Increased Fire Protection.*
- *Lower Homeowners (fire) Insurance Rate (average 5-15%).*
- *Increased Property Values w/o automatically increasing assessment. Re-assessments DO NOT automatically take place because of a Water District being created.*
- *Enhanced marketability of property in the future.*
- *Less worry about water supply.*
- *Eliminate costs associated with private wells.*

Water System Implementation

- Distribute Petitions for Signature. (**DONE**)
- Hold a Legal Public Hearing (**Tonight**).
- NYS Comptrollers Application. (**4-6 Months**)
- Adopt a Bond Resolution. (**2 months**)
- Secure Grants and Loans (**DONE**)

Water System Implementation

- *Prepare Contract Plans and Specifications (4-6 Months)*
- *Obtain Approvals, Permits, Easements, etc. (3-5 Months)*
- *Bidding Phase (2 Months)*
- *Construction Phase (6-9 Months)*
- *Restoration of Project Area (2-3 Months)*
- ***Project Completion GOAL is December 31, 2021***

Questions and Answers

- **If I don't want water, will I have to pay for it?**
 - You'll have to pay for the water district debt, but if you don't hook-up, you don't pay for water use.
- **Will the project raise my assessment?**
 - No, your assessment does not change, your tax bill will include a separate water district tax. Re-assessments DO NOT take place because of a Water District being created.
- **If I don't sign up immediately, can I hook-up later?**
 - Yes, but you will have to pay a tap-in fee at a later date.
