Please accept this letter of concern because of the resurgence of Covid-19 positive cases in Genesee County. We are fighting each day to go about our business, keep our families safe, maintain in-school opportunities for our students and represent you with our work ethic.

As part of our local government unit, we request your full compliance with the State of Emergency Rules put into place by Governor Cuomo.

With your help and model behavior we can be the best examples for residents of Genesee County to step up in taking precautions to fight the spread of COVID 19.

This week Eric and Monroe Counties have been put under Micro-Cluster Yellow Zone Restrictions. Our goal is to avoid being put under further restriction in Genesee County. We can only achieve this with your complete attention to detail and following the rules put into place during this pandemic.

All Towns, Villages, Fire Districts and Departments, as part of our Public Safety force in the county, are reminded of the following:

- 1. Fire Halls and Town Halls and Recreation Centers cannot host BINGO games yet.
- Limit of 50 people for non-essential gatherings indoor or outdoor, public or private property. If renting a facility, the caterer and wait staff count towards the 50 person limit. NYS Executive Order 202,45
- 3. Rentals of your property for meetings—non-essential are limited to 50 for in-person meetings.

Here is the risk of non-compliance:

-Gatherings that exceed to 50-person limit are subject to \$15,000 fine per NYS Executive Order 202.8. The owner of a facility, caterer or sponsor of the event is liable. A Summons and Complaint will be served through Public Health law.

-Persons not masking when in public are subject to \$1,000 fine per NYS Executive Order 202.8, on an individual basis. A Summons and complaint will be served through Public

Health law.

NYS established a Complaint Line for reporting large gatherings and non-masking activities. Our mandated duty is to follow up on all complaints in Genesce County. Law Enforcement and Public Health must investigate each complaint and follow with appropriate action. Please be well aware of your personal liability and risk to your local governmental unit if a complaint is lodged at one of your facilities. Property tax dollars that support local government units would be wasted in a violation situation.

This notice of social distancing, masking and limited gatherings is meant to help prevent COVID-19 fatigue. Yet more importantly, this reminder is to ensure your safety and well-being and that of your family as well. If you own a business, you want to remain open to serve your customers. If you have health related underlying issues, we want to do

our part to protect you.

Only through calm, purposeful measures will we emerge from this Pandemic. Our actions have consequences let's make them be positive ones, together.
