Town of Bergen- Proposed Language change for Employee Handbook- Regarding Milage (9/10/2024) (note proposed change is in red)

**Reimbursement of milage.** Milage will be reimbursed at a rate set by the Town Board at its annual meeting and may be based upon the IRS guidelines. Request for milage reimbursement must specify the dates, place and total milage. Milage reimbursement will be provided for official town business and will only be payable from the employee's office to and from the work required destination. If the employee starts from their home to a required work destination other than their office, the milage reimbursement will be based upon the distance from the employee's office and the required work destination.

**Reimbursement for mileage**. Mileage will be reimbursed at the rate set by the Town Board at its annual meeting and may be based upon the IRS guideline. Request for mileage reimbursement must specify the dates, place and total mileage.

**Receipts required for travel expenditures**. All travel expenditures must be documented with receipts attached to the voucher.

**Voucher submission to Town Clerk**. In order to avoid delay of travel payments, all vouchers must be submitted to the Town Clerk at least one business day before the regularly scheduled Board meeting.

**Reimbursement for meals**. The maximum reimbursement for meals is \$50 a day/\$70 a day NYC. Note: this is a maximum allowance; receipts must be attached. Alcoholic beverages cannot be included for reimbursement. A gratuity of up to 15% may be added to the above. An exception to the above meal allowances would be allowed for group meals when includes as part of the conference. (they should be included under registration).

Reimbursement of actual costs of lodging and transportation. The Town will reimburse the actual costs of lodging and transportation. An exception to this is if alternate methods of transportation are readily available and cheaper, the Town reserves the right to limit reimbursement to the cheaper alternative. "Example: if airfare is \$125 and mileage is \$140, the Town could limit reimbursement to \$125. This would be stated at the time of Board approval of the trip).

**Advance payment**. the Town will advance payment for lodging, registration fees and public transportation only. (This does not reduce the need for receipts upon return).

# Personal Telephone Calls

# MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING

BETWEEN TOWN OF BERGEN AND MEMBERS OF TEAMSTERS LOCAL 264 EFFECTIVE SEPTEMBER 11, 2024

In regards to the Union Contract in effect January 1, 2022 through December 31, 2025, Article 24, Section 24.1 which reads: "The Town will pay the full cost of renting and laundering five changes per week of work uniforms for all full-time highway employees," the Town and the Union agree to the following change without consideration or alteration to any other terms of the Union Contract:

The Town of Bergen will provide appropriate shirts for full-time highway employees to wear. The Town will also provide an annual stipend of \$250 for the purchase of jeans to wear to work. The \$250 will be paid in a lump sum to each employee upon submission of receipt(s) proving purchase of the jeans. All receipts must be submitted by December 1 each year to ensure processing in the December abstract. The reimbursement will be treated according to IRS regulations. It is understood that the highway employees are responsible for laundering this clothing and that they are required to wear the shirts provided by the Town.
